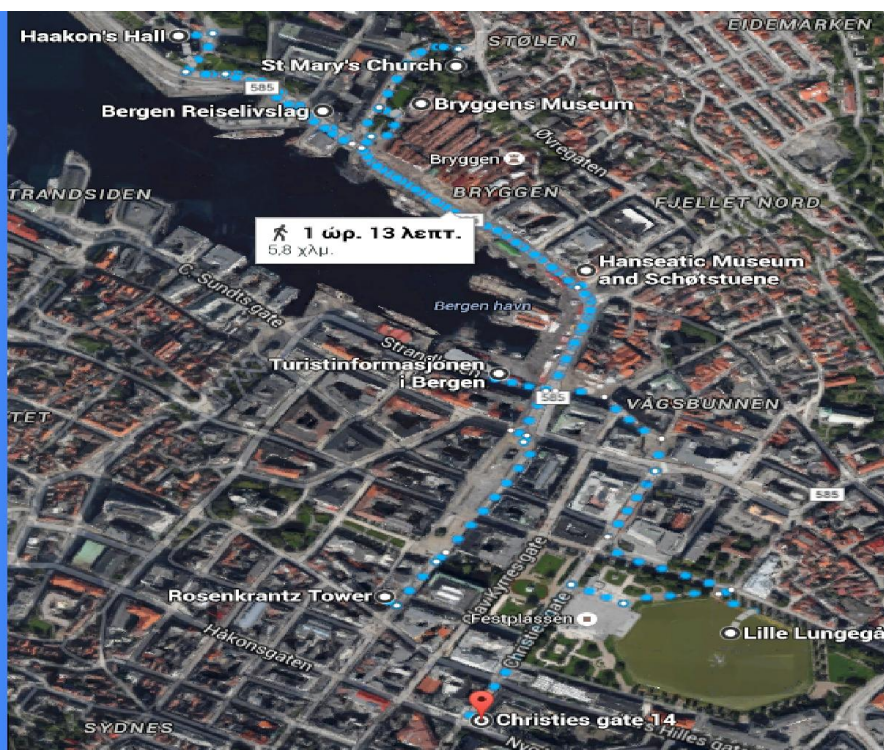

1. [Det Høyskolemuseet og Schoetstuen](#)

Small museum set in a historical merchant house. Each room describes an aspect of the merchants' life in old Bergen. Very interesting



2. [Bryggen Hanseatic Wharf](#)

Must see. Great view and atmosphere. Unique historical value that you cannot find many other places. A variety of restaurants and main hotels.



3. [Bryggens Museum - Bymuseet i Bergen](#)

It has interesting facts about Bryggens. I never knew about the fire accident so it was very interesting. I wish they had brochures in English but pictures had English explanations so it was good.



4. [St. Mary Church](#)

We went there and it was very pretty and preserved. It's worth a visit, not a long one but still nice to see! You can see the beautiful details that have been preserved for so many years



5. [Bergen Tourist Information](#)

Opens at 9.00. Staff supplied me with BERGEN card, informed about the usability, showed me the main attractions at museums and routes that I could do with the buses to get to know the city. They also briefed me on the fjord cruises. **Thus helped choose exploration sognefjord**, where was the best choice for someone who had not much time to do multi-day trip to the fjords, as it was the most representative by boat and train. It also has a wealth of material that help the visitor.



6. Rosenkrantz Tower - Bymuseet i Bergen

This is an interesting site, however we decided not to pay to get inside after others had told us it wasn't very interesting. On the outside you can explore ruins and read plaques about what happened on the site.



7. Haakon's Hall - Bymuseet i Bergen

Haakon's Hall adjoins the Rosenkrantz Tower and was all part of a larger fortified area. The main thing to see here is the very large "baronial" hall, but there is also access to the rooms in the under-croft. The building was badly damaged when a German ammunition ship exploded in the harbour just below, but has been restored and modified slightly for modern use. The immense wooden ceiling is particularly impressive. Allow 30minutes for your visit and then enjoy walking in the surrounding gardens.



8. Bergen Fortress

A good place for a stroll with lovely views all round. However, there is really nothing to see on the inside. It takes 15-20 minutes to view all the empty rooms inside this huge fortress.



8a. Bergenshus Festning

This part was seriously destroyed by bombs during the world war II. Rebuilt to original design and today used for important representative events. Scandinavian design and furniture makes this an important museum. One of oldest and best preserved fortresses in the country. The Hákon's Hall and Rosenkrantz Tower are situated in the fortress grounds. The Hákon's Hall was built as royal residence and banquet hall by king Hákon Hákonson before 750 years. The Rosenkrantz Tower is regarded as the most important renaissance building in Norway.



9. [Mount Floyen and the Funicular \(Floibanen\)](#)

Don't miss it. This fantastic funicular helps you, it connects city center with Fløien vantage point which is great starting place for longer trips. If you haven't enough time you can of course go there and back but if you can stay a few hours walk farther away. I can advise you to go up to Fjellhytten cottage and then to Blåmanen, you can find them on the map board at Fløien. I promise you will enjoy romantic paths, great views and a touch of real Norwegian wilderness.



10. [Lille Lungegaardsvannet](#)

As you stroll away from the harbor into the center of Bergen you will discover a **park with a small tree-lined lake, a fountain, and a gazebo surrounded by a large and impressive display of flowering plants.** This is a wonderful place to sit and enjoy a peaceful rest. It is truly beautiful.



11. [Stoltzekleiven](#)

5.9 Km away N from Bergen

I recommend you to walk Stoltzen if you are in Bergen city. **Its a very tough route, but you get a wonderful feeling on top of the mountain.** Beautiful view. The trail is very well made.



12. [The Royal Residence \(Gamlehaugen\)](#)

7.3Km away S from Bergen (3,7Km from 13)

A little outside of Bergen but worth it to see. The ground to the palace are stunning with a beautiful lake surrounding. The inside has very specific entry times so be sure to check.



13. [Fantoft Stavkirke](#)

10.7Km S away from Bergen (3,7 Km from 12)

This is something unique to Norway. They are old and charming and very interesting to visit. The roof decorations and interesting. It is something that I do not believe exists elsewhere.
