Dear Partners,

As Wizz Abu Dhabi will start up flights to AUH from your stations, please find below the National Travel Protocol of Abu Dhabi Authorities:

1. Arrivals to UAE:

- Residents are allowed to enter UAE after updating their data on [uaeentry.ica.gov.ae]uaeentry.ica.gov.ae
- International Tourists are allowed to enter the UAE. (holding only Abu Dhabi issued Visa) in regard to the passengers holding visas issued from other emirates (Not Abu Dhabi):
 - They can depart from Abu Dhabi.
 - They can arrive to Abu Dhabi only if they are coming from the green countries.*
 - Passengers should fill up the health declaration form before arriving to UAE.
 - PCR test result is required for all passengers regardless to their departure country. The test should be conducted within <u>72 hours</u> before arriving to UAE. Only passengers with negative PCR results are allowed to travel to UAE.
 - The PCR Result should be in form of QR code for some countries and conducted within 72 hours before arriving to UAE. Only passengers with negative PCR results are allowed to travel to UAE.
 - All passengers should have health insurance coverage during their stay in UAE before arriving to UAE.
 - Passengers should follow all the precautionary measures to limit the spread of COVID-19
 - Passengers should download the health tracing application (ALHOSN)

A. Arrivals from green countries:

- Must undergo a PCR test upon arrival and self-isolate until they receive a negative result.
- If they intend to stay in Abu Dhabi for longer than 6 consecutive days must undergo a PCR test on day 6, and on day 12 if they remain for 12 consecutive days.

B. Arrivals from red countries:

 must undergo a PCR test upon arrival and quarantine for 10 days. They must undergo another PCR test on day 8.

The vaccinated citizens and residents arrivals who completed 28 days after the second dose:

- Arriving from green countries: must undergo a PCR test upon arrival and self-isolate until they receive a negative result. They must undergo another PCR test on day 6, without the need to quarantine.
- Arriving from red countries: must undergo a PCR upon arrival and quarantine for 5 days. They must undergo another PCR test on day 4.

2. Departures from UAE:

- Travelling is allowed based on countries requirements and procedures for entering the international passengers.
- Do a PCR test <u>72 hours</u> before departure, and the holders of negative results only are allowed to depart (some destinations required 48 hours).
- Not advisable for those over 70 years or having chronic diseases to travel, exempts those who travel for treatment.
- Emiratis should register in the Twajudi service prior to travel
- Passengers should follow all the precautionary measures of the destination countries and during the flight. Some destinations require less than 72 hours for the PCR results (Get the confirmation from the embassies or the airlines).

Note: list of country classifications will be reviewed regularly and subject to change based on global COVID-19 developments (https://visitabudhabi.ae/en/plan-your-trip/covid-safe-travel/permitted-countries/.

Additionally, please be advised that a Green travel corridor has been activated between Greece and Abu Dhabi, without the need of passengers to be quarantined on arrival to AUH from Greece.

Passengers don't need to quarantine when flying to or from a 'travel corridor' country, if have been fully vaccinated (final dose received at least 28 days before travel).

They will have to consider checking the vaccination status from the official applications such as Al Hosn in UAE.

The passengers still **should have a negative PCR taken within 72 hours before the flight**. They will undergo another PCR upon arrival and on day 6.
